MARQUES, AJ

[1] This is an application for leave to appeal brought by the Applicant against the whole judgment and order of this Court issued on 30 May 2025 in terms of which the Applicant was ordered to:

2.1 The Application to reinstate the Applicant's review application is dismissed.
